Clarice Ann Gordon aged 90 of Ludington passed away on Friday, August 5, 2016 at Tendercare of Ludington following a brief illness. Clarice was born on February 12, 1926 in Midland, the daughter of Frederick and Beatrice Kortge. She grew up in the household alongside her four brothers Eulan, Corliss, Dean, and Cleon, all who have preceded her in death. On November 23, 1955 she married Donald Gordon in a ceremony conducted by her grandfather George Griswold, who served as Justice of the Peace.
