Harvey Jay Buter, aged 78, of Ludington, went to his heavenly home on June 10, 2015. Harvey worked for years at Clark Floor Machine in Muskegon and Simonds Industries in Big Rapids before retiring to Scottville. Harvey was an antique car enthusiast, having restored a 1930 Model A, 1936 Ford and other various cars throughout the years. He was a charter and active member of the Portside A's Model A Club. Harvey was also an active member of First Christian Reformed Church in Muskegon, Fellowship Christian Reformed Church in Big Rapids, Mason County Reformed Church in Scottville, and Trinity Evangelical Free Church in Ludington.

Harvey is survived by his wife of 8 months, Penny Yost-Buter.
