Kerry Lynn Howe aged 59 of Ludington passed away on Tuesday, January 1, 2019 at her home. Kerry was born on August 27, 1959 in Manistee, the daughter of Leonard D. and Lorna J. (Dumas) Howe, and graduated from Manistee High School with the class of 1977. She furthered her education at Central Michigan University earning an Associate's Degree in Business in 1979.
