Shirley Jean Taranto-Petroski aged 78 of Branch, formerly of Williamston, beloved wife, mother, sister, aunt, cousin and friend passed away peacefully Friday evening July 26, 2019 at her home.

Shirley was born on May 4, 1941 in Lansing, the daughter of John and Stella (Klieber) Hasford and graduated from Resurrection High School with the class of 1959. Following graduation, she served her country with the United States Air Force.

On October 8, 2005 she married Richard F. Petroski at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Williamston and they have been blessed with 14 years together.
