Alma Roselyn Rhinebolt aged 82 of Scottville passed away on Tuesday, April 12, 2022. Alma was born on June 27, 1939 in Scottville, the daughter of Ai William and Pearl Mildred (Buffenbarger) Durham. On June 1, 1957, she married Frederick Galen Rhinebolt and they celebrated 63 years together before Fred preceded her in death on September 3, 2020. 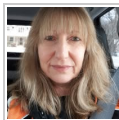

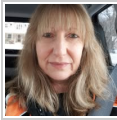

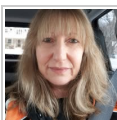
