Betty Anna Englebrecht, aged 96 of Custer, formerly of Riverton Township, died Saturday, October 13, 2007 at Oakview Medical Care Facility in Ludington. Betty was born on March 14, 1911 in Hill Rose, Colorado to Robert and Metta (Anderson) Nelson, and earned a teaching certificate from County Normal School. She taught school in the Riverton area. On June 18, 1933, she married Henry Englebrecht in Oceana County, and he preceded her in death on July 12, 1984. She was also preceded in death by her daughter Virginia Augustine on April 16, 2003, her brothers Robert and Carl Nelson, and her sister Violet Morrell.
