Clifford J. Reed age 83 of Scottville passed away on Tuesday, May 13, 2025. Clifford was born on August 7, 1941 in Macomb, Illinois, the son of Clarence C. and Dorothy P. (Barclay) Reed and served his country during the Vietnam Conflict with the United States Air Force. On April 25, 1963, he married Maureen C. Quinn in Bethesda, Maryland and they celebrated 49 years together before Maureen preceded him in death in 2012. Clifford was also preceded in death by his parents, his granddaughter Tina Stakenas, his brother Claud "Marion" Reed, and his sister-in-law Patricia Petersen.
