Dorothy Alyce “Dee” McCumber, aged 56 of Fountain, died peacefully on Thursday, September 6, 2018, surrounded by her family. Dee was born on January 6, 1962 in Washington, DC, the daughter of Robert and Dorothy (Fowler) Bender and graduated from Lakeland High School in Lakeland, Florida with the class of 1980. On August 6, 1983, she married Ralph E. McCumber at White Pine Village in Ludington and he preceded her in death on February 11, 2000. Dee was also preceded in death by her daughter, Alyce McCumber, in 1985, her parents, Robert & Dorothy, her in-laws Ralph & Dorothy McCumber and Jack & Lorraine Nankee, and her sister-in-law, Barbara Sheppard.
