Evelyn Jean Pehr aged 96 of Ludington, passed away on Saturday, June 29, 2019. Jean was born on October 1, 1922 in Decatur, Michigan, the daughter of the late Sylvester and Irene (Mattox) Sunday. On March 11, 1939, she married Robert G. Pehr and he preceded her in death in 1988. Jean resided in Muskegon before moving to Ludington in 2005.

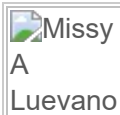
