



## Gladys May Schoenherr

August 27, 1923 - July 16, 2008

Mrs. Gladys M. Schoenherr, aged 84 of Reed City, formerly of Fountain, died Wednesday, July 16, 2008 at Memorial Medical Center in Ludington. Gladys was born on August 27, 1923 in Sherman Township to Alonzo and Edna (Corsaut) Wright and graduated from Custer High School. On March 8, 1941, she married Fred W. Schoenherr, and they celebrated 53 years together before Fred preceded her in death on August 23, 1994.
