OBITUARY: Henry George Mishler, aged 63 of Branch passed away suddenly at his home on Wednesday, June 30, 2010. Henry was born on May 2, 1947 in Cadillac to Elmer and Mary (Helsel) Mishler, and grew up in the Cadillac area.
