John Edward Lynn aged 76 of Ludington passed away on Wednesday, May 12, 2021 at his home surrounded by his family. John was born on July 2, 1944 in Muskegon, the son of Evert William and Margaret Thelma (Posthumus) Lynn. On March 9, 1974 he married Florice May Marrison at the Scottville United Methodist Church and they have celebrated 47 years by each other's side.
