September 15, 1917 - January 10, 2008

Mr. Joseph Mickevich, aged 90 of Fountain, passed away on Thursday, January 10, 2008 at Memorial Medical Center of West Michigan. Joseph was born on September 15, 1917 in Connecticut to Florenz and Eva (Manciones) Mickevich, and married Josephine Genson on August 22, 1940 in Traverse City. They have celebrated 67 years together. Joseph operated the Mickevich Garage and Service Station in Fountain with his brother Felix for 37 years, retiring in 1972.
