Katharine Ann "Katie" (Mudrovich) McPike age 81 of Ludington, MI passed away on Tuesday, August 5, 2025 surrounded by her loving family. Katie was born on November 18, 1943 in Monroe, MI, the oldest daughter of Thomas and Mildred Mudrovich. After graduating high school in Monroe, Katie attended Central Michigan University where she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Education, and later earned her Master's degree from Butler University in Library Science. In 1967 she married Ray Bill McPike in Monroe, where they raised their two children before moving to Indianapolis, Indiana. After spending ten years in Indiana, Ray Bill and Katie moved to Ludington where Katie taught at Mason County Eastern School in Custer and was a Librarian for the Mason County District Library.

Katie was a wonderful wife and an incredible mother and grandmother. She was a very impressive woman who had a wealth of knowledge. She was "Siri" before there was Siri. There was hardly a subject she didn't have some knowledge about and provide great insight. She was the president of the Junior League in Indianapolis, Junior warden for Grace Episcopal Church for over 20 years, P.E.O. FG chapter President, and was involved with Friends of the Library. She enjoyed reading, traveling, playing games with family and friends, knitting, watching the beautiful Lake Michigan sunsets, and especially spending time with her grandchildren. Katie was the pillar of her family and will be greatly missed.
