A celebration of his life will be held in Ludington at a date to be announced later. Those who wish to make a contribution in Larry memory can do so to a

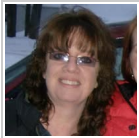
charity of the donor's choice.

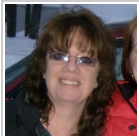
