LEATRICE'S OBITUARY: Mrs. Leatrice J. Stevens, age 88 formerly of Scottville, passed away at Tendercare of Ludington on Tuesday, October 4, 2011. Leatrice was born to Henry and Cecil Mae Matevjovitz on June 18, 1923 in Custer. She grew up in Custer with her sister Linda and attended the local rural schools, and graduated from Scottville High School. On July 1, 1944 she was wed to Albert Pratt. They lived in Muskegon for a few years following their marriage and then returned to Scottville where they raised their family of three boys, Gar, Ron and Warren.
