OBITUARY: Lenora Ellen Hissong, aged 86 of Jenison formerly a lifelong resident of Custer, passed away on Friday, May 11, 2012 at Metro Health Hospital in Wyoming. Lenora was born on January 9, 1926 in Custer Township to William Henry and Emma (Slagle) Bacon, and graduated from Custer High School with the class of 1943. On January 5, 1946, she married Glenn W. Hissong in Scottville, and they celebrated 48 years together before Glenn preceded her in death on April 5, 1994. She was also preceded in death by her parents, her brothers Eugene and Merwin Bacon, and her sister Clara Hissong. Lenora and Glenn raised their five children south of Custer, where her love of being a mom shone brightly.
