Margaret Luedke, aged 90 of Summit Township, passed away peacefully on Monday, November 24, 2014 in the home of her birth. Margaret was born on May 27, 1924, the daughter of Ralph and Atlanta (Christoffersen) Kistler, and graduated from Ludington High School with the class of 1942. On June 29, 1944, she married George Luedke in Chicago, and they celebrated 43 years together before George preceded her in death in 1987. Margaret was also preceded in death by her son David in 2002, her parents, and her brothers Lyle, Lee, and Vern Kistler.
