Ramon “Raymond” Martinez aged 72 of Ludington passed away on Sunday, July 15, 2018. Ramon was born on January 21, 1946 in San Antonio, Texas, the fourth of five sons born to Merced and Margarita (Soto) Martinez. In 1958 they moved their family to Mason County and strived to teach their sons how to work and make an honest living. Ramon attended Free Soil schools where he participated in track, winning many awards and ribbons, and also participated in basketball and baseball for the Free Soil Pirates. He graduated in 1965 and began working for Great Lakes Castings in Ludington where he worked for the next 47 years until his retirement in 2012. He was a proud member of UAW Local 1464.

Ramon loved vintage cars and riding around the area listening to his favorite “oldies” music. This hobby was second only to his love for his children and grandchildren and being in their company. Ramon was a man of few words, but once he got to know you, you couldn’t leave unless he told you at least two stories about his youth and lessons he had learned. 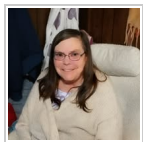
