



## Reva May Gulembo

July 16, 1930 - December 3, 2016

Reva May Gulembo aged 86 of Fountain passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 3, 2016. Reva was born on July 16, 1930 in Ithaca, the daughter of William and Grace Grice, and graduated from Ithaca High School. While attending college in Lansing, she met Corliss T. “Corky” Gulembo and they married on April 7, 1951 in Ithaca. Corky preceded her in death in 1996.
