Richard Leroy Lemire, aged 75 of Scottville passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at Mercy Health Partners in Muskegon. Richard was born on January 10, 1941 in Ludington, the son of Roy and Blanche (French) Lemire and grew up in the Mason County area with his four sisters and two brothers.
