Roger A. Leonard age 58 of Ludington passed away on Friday, March 7, 2025. Roger was born on August 18, 1966 in Ludington, the son of Richard and Carol (Davis) Leonard and graduated from Mason County Central High School with the class of 1985. 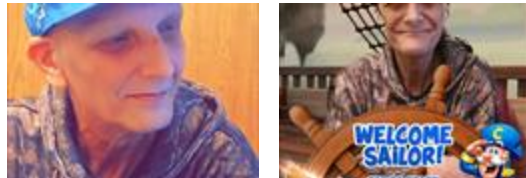
