



## Roger Albert Vitucki

OBITUARY: Roger A. Vitucki, aged 74 of Scottville, passed away on Sunday, September 4, 2011 at Spectrum Health-Butterworth Campus in Grand Rapids. Roger was born on January 19, 1937 in Grant Township to George and Veronica (Grabowski) Vitucki and graduated from Scottville High School with the class of 1956. In 1962 he married the love of his life Betty in Ludington, and they celebrated 41 years together before Betty preceded him in death in 2003.
