



## Rolland David Miller

April 9, 1922 - July 15, 2010

OBITUARY: Rolland D. Miller, aged 88 of Custer passed away on Thursday, July 15, 2010 at Tendercare of Ludington. Rolland was born on April 9, 1922 in Custer Township, the son of Clarence and Thelma (Fager) Miller, and grew up in the Scottville area. He served his country with the U.S. Navy Construction Battalion during World War II in the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre, earning the Victory Medal, 3 Stars Medal, and a Good Conduct Medal. On September 7, 1946 he married Dorothy Sommerfeldt in Sherman Township, and they celebrated 52 years together before Dorothy preceded him in death on August 20, 1999. Rolland was a lifelong member of the Redeemer Lutheran Church in Scottville, worked as an Operating Engineer and was a proud member of the Local 324 of Michigan for 68 years. Along with his wife Dorothy, Rolland was preceded in death by his parents, and his sisters Irene Hanson and June Chilberg. He will be lovingly remembered by his sons Preston D.
