Stanton Lyle Haner aged 65 of Ludington passed away on October 9, 2020 in Grand Rapids following a short illness. Stanton was able to be comforted by his wife and children in his last days.

Stanton was born on September 6, 1955 in the Catskills of New York, the son of Stanley L. and Leona V. (Tompkins) Haner and graduated from Jefferson Central High School in New York.
