



## Victoria Jean Trim

August 29, 1959 - September 24, 2015

Victoria Jean "Vicki" Trim, aged 56 of Branch, MI passed away on Thursday, September 24, 2015 at Spectrum Health Ludington Hospital. 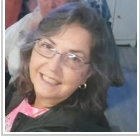
