William T. "Bill" Hopkins age 71 of Scottville passed away peacefully on Wednesday evening October 16, 2024 at his home in Scottville surrounded by his family. Bill was born on December 15, 1952 in Kalamazoo, one of three children to William L. and Arlene (Weber) Hopkins and graduated from Portage Central High school in 1971. Following school, he was drafted into the Army 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell in Kentucky where he held the rank of a Specialist and specialized in the Vulcan Anti-aircraft gun. Bill drove semi-truck for over 48 years hauling a wide variety of freight from cold foods to paper.

Bill enjoyed being outside and was always found golfing, hunting, attending his daughters rodeos, or kayaking with family and friends. He enjoyed sitting on his porch watching nature and on Sundays cheering on (yelling at) his favorite team the Detroit Lions.
